

(Applicant) requests non-standard water service from McCoy Water Supply Corporation (McCoy WSC or Corporation) to property (Property) located inside/outside the Corporation's certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) or service area. Applicant understands and agrees that retail water service will only be available under the terms and conditions of the McCoy WSC's Tariff, Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ") regulations, the Texas Water Code and the Texas Health & Safety Code.

By signing and submitting this application for non-standard retail water utility service, Applicant declares that he/she/it is the owner of the property in question or a developer with legal contractual rights to develop the property. If the Applicant is not the landowner or developer, he/she/it must have written legal authority to make this application and to bind the landowner/developer to the terms of any resulting service contract. [Attach copy of sworn power of attorney]

The information requested below shall be the minimum information required of the Applicant to request non-standard service to the Property. Applicant shall also be required to timely provide any additional information required by McCoy WSC and/or the McCoy WSC-designated consulting engineers to evaluate this service request, its effects on the Corporation's existing facilities and distribution system and its members, and any additional service capacities that might need to be developed to fulfill this request.

Please Note: This is only an application for Non-Standard Service. McCoy WSC is not obligated to provide service until the application has been fully evaluated; the Corporation's Board of Directors have approved the Non Standard Services Contract; all necessary costs and fees have been received by the Corporation; and the Non Standard Services Contract has been executed by the Applicant and by the McCoy WSC Board President or his designee.
