Payment Options:

Auto draft- McCoy offers ACH auto bank draft at no charge to our customers. Payments are drafted on the 14th of every month. Sign up today!!

Drop box-We have a drop box available inside the UPS Store located at 1240 W. Oaklawn in Pleasanton. **You may conveniently drop off your payment during UPS store business* hours. We also have a drop box location at the McCoy Office located outside the entrance gate.

You may also pay at any HEB or Walmart locations with your bill stub. (*Payments may take 24-48 hours to process and post*). Please be advised, HEB or Walmart will only process your payment and they will *not* process your meter readings.

Customer Information:

Billing Dates:

The bills are mailed by the 1st of the month and are due by the end of the business day on the 15th to avoid a penalty. The *final day to pay* is the 28th to avoid interruption of service.

Meter Readings:

Your meter readings are due from the 1st to the 15th of every month. Meter readings received after the 15th will not be processed. Please ensure you submit your readings monthly to avoid a service fee of \$55.00. We do offer a service to read your meter for \$7.50 a month.

Senior Exempt Program:

If you are over the age of 60 or disabled, please call our office to sign up for this program.

Call 811 before you dig:

Texas Law requires residents to call for locates BEFORE you dig. Any damage incurred due to failure to call for a locate will be the property owner's responsibility.
